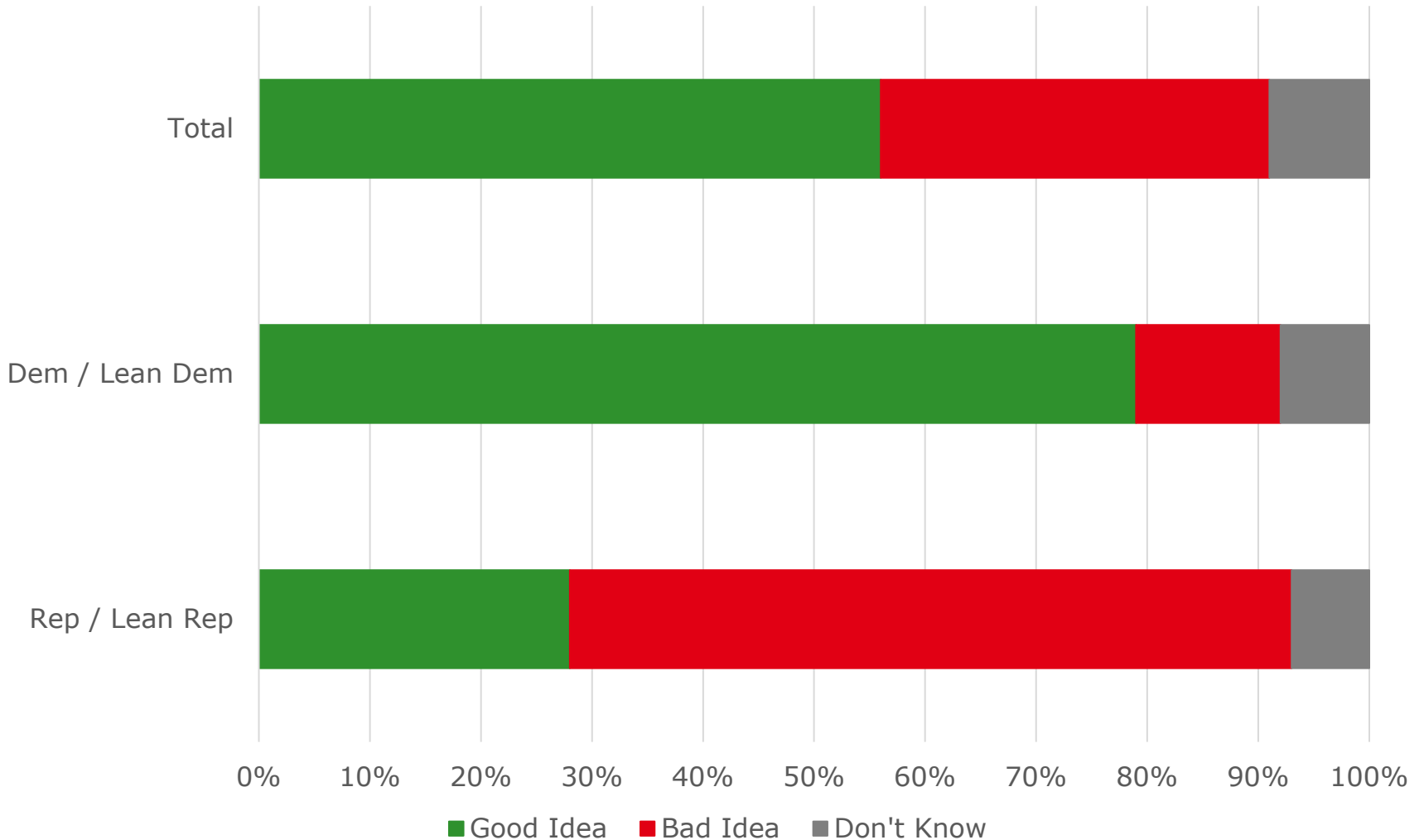

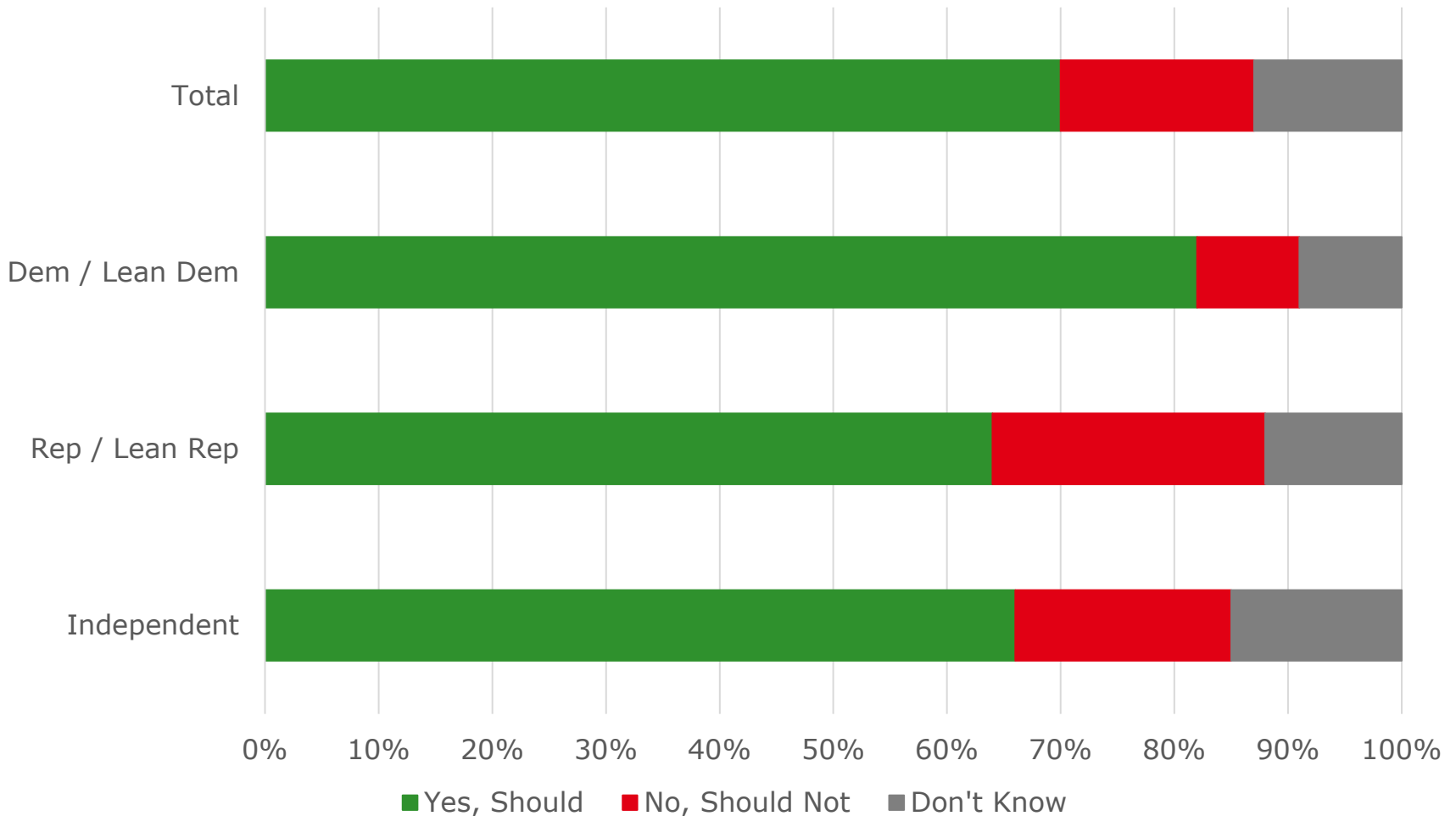

Agreement with the 2009 Economic Stimulus Plan



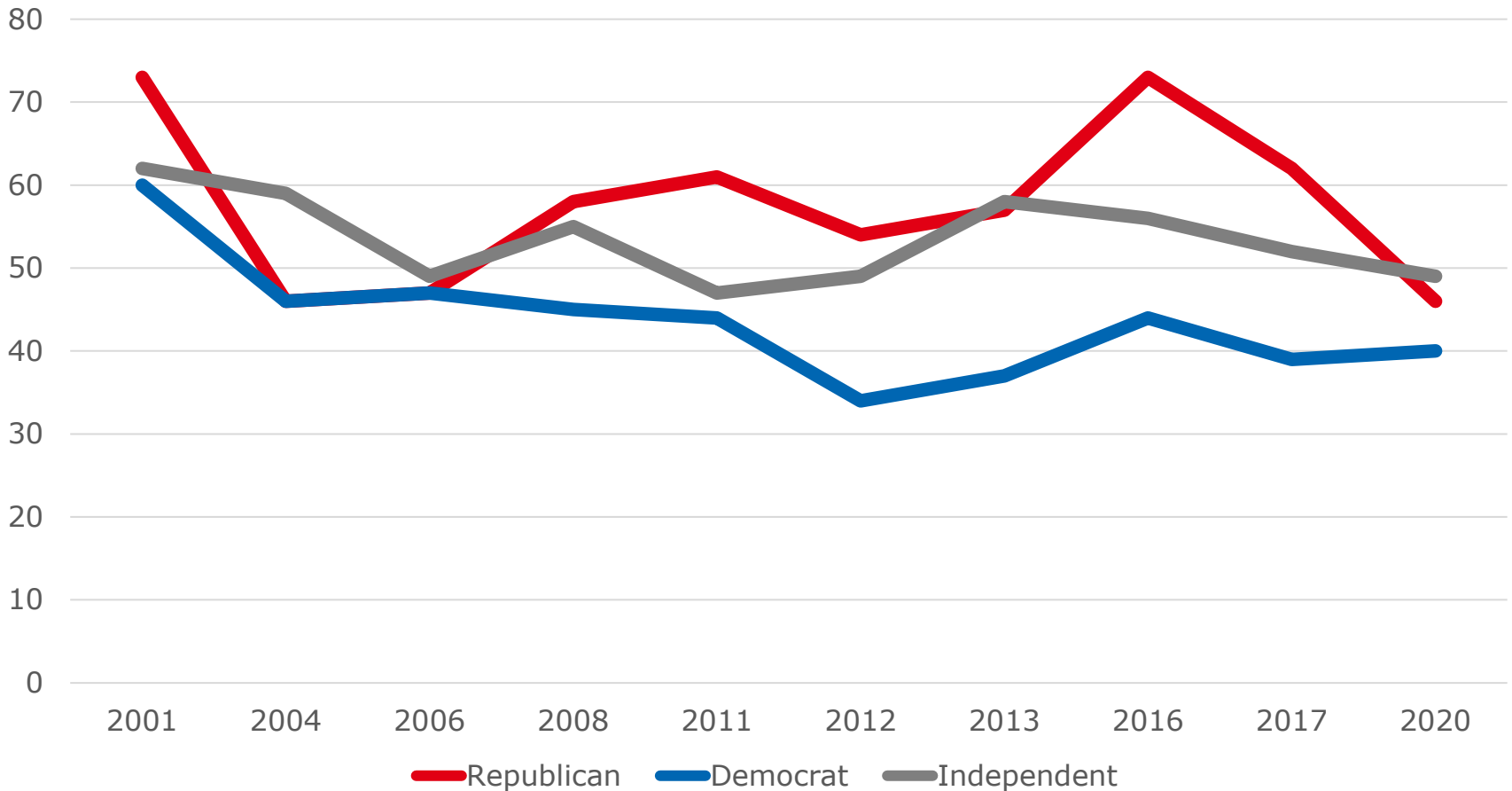

Should the Federal Government Make Another One-Time Stimulus Payment?



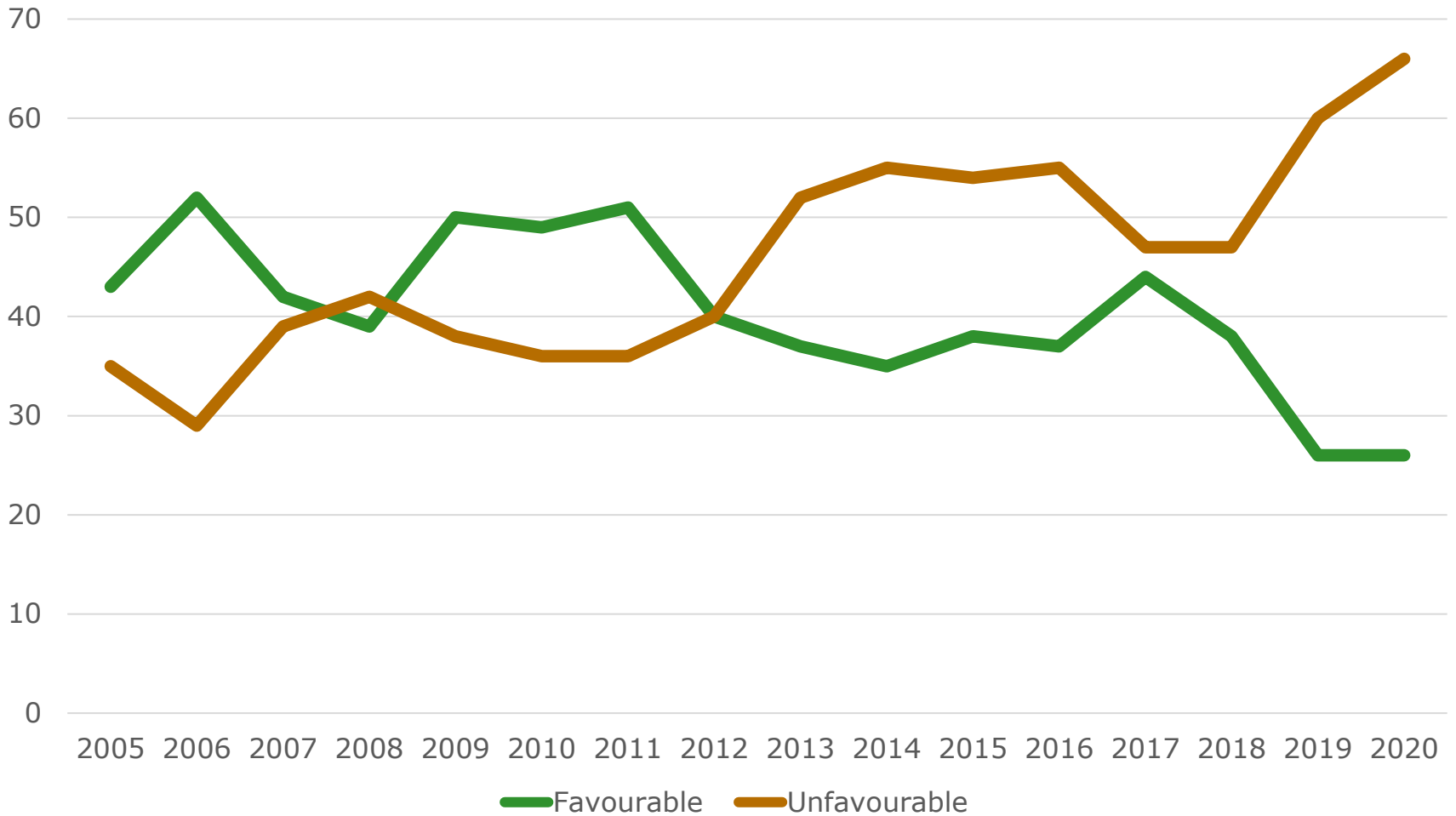
